BRIEF OUTLINE OF SERVICES:

The Student Services Division of the Department of Education and Training supports children with hearing impairment through an advisory teacher service. The services provided are determined by the needs of the child and availability of resources.

CHILDREN OF SCHOOL AGE

SERVICES GENERALLY INVOLVE:

- * working directly with the student to develop the student's communication, language and speech skills
- * professional development and support to teachers of students with hearing impairment in all schools throughout the Northern Territory

INFANTS

A service is offered to babies and young children not yet of school age. This service generally involves:

- * working directly with the young child to develop communication, language and speech skills.
- * supporting families to understand and provide for the hearing needs of the child.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

CHILDREN OF SCHOOL AGE

Schools follow the guidelines and procedures outlined in the "Request for Service" guidelines when requesting services from Student Services Division.

INFANTS

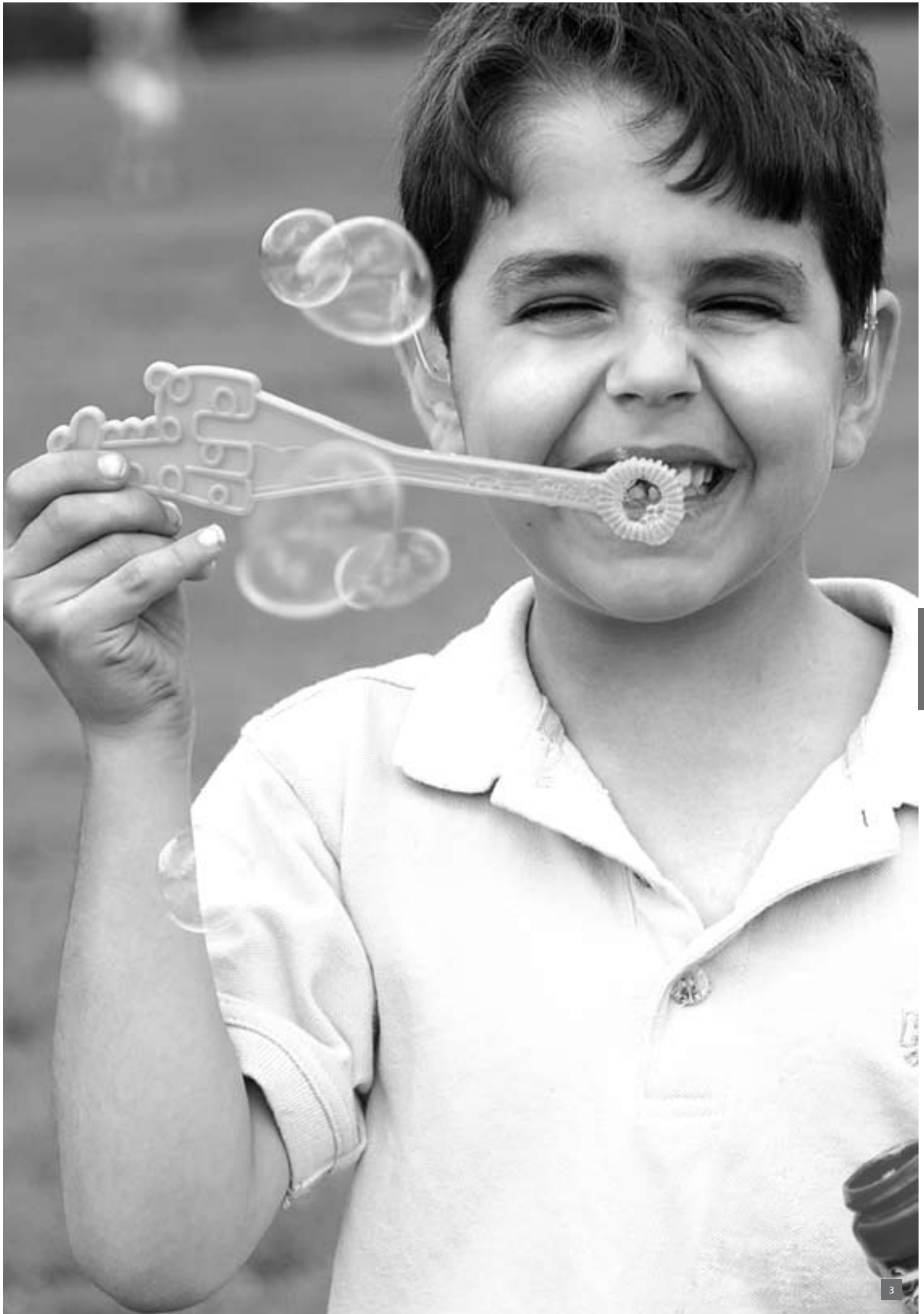
Parents and guardians of babies and young children not of school age should contact the Hearing Coordinator, to request the services of an Education Advisor for Hearing.
